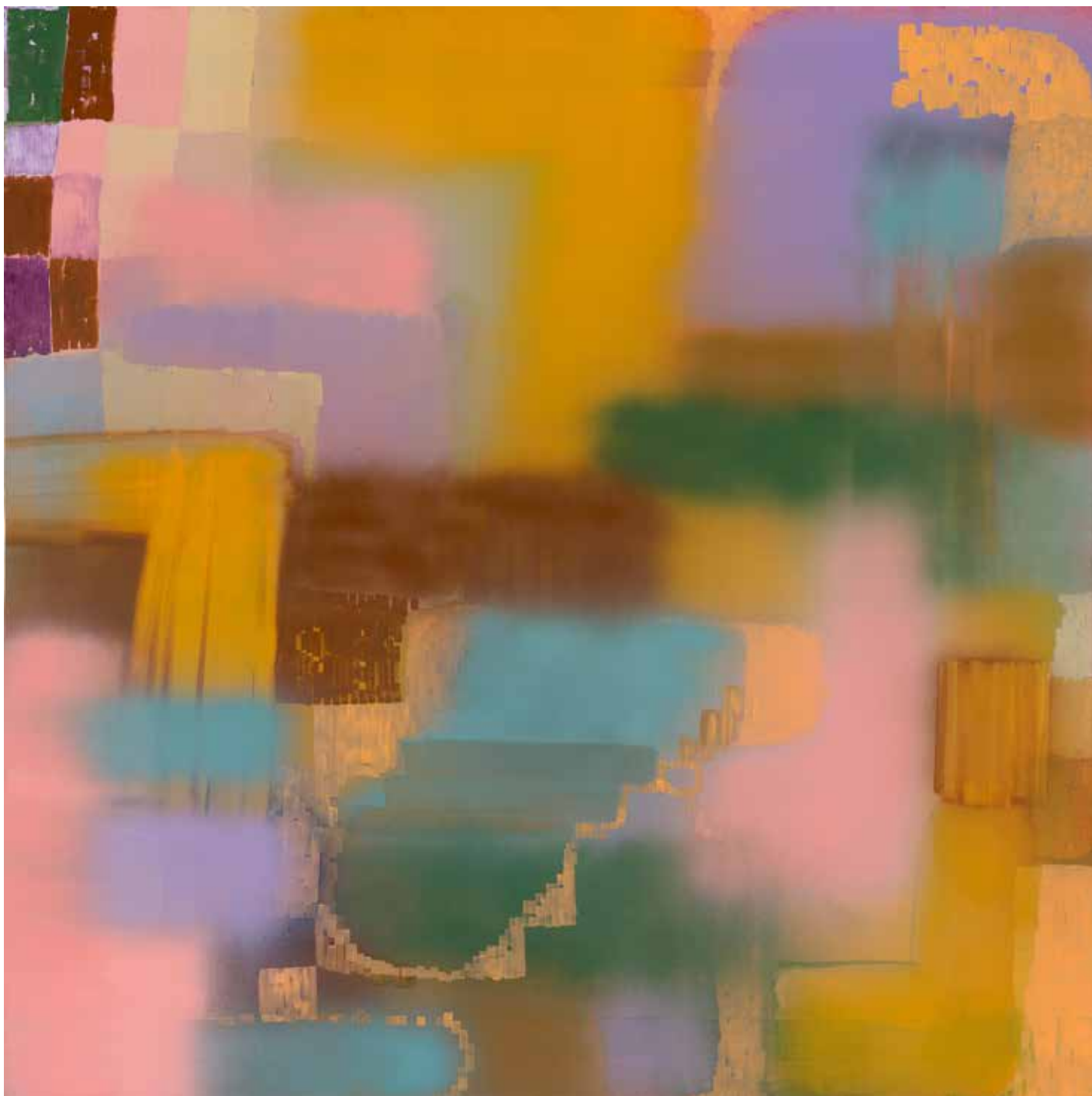
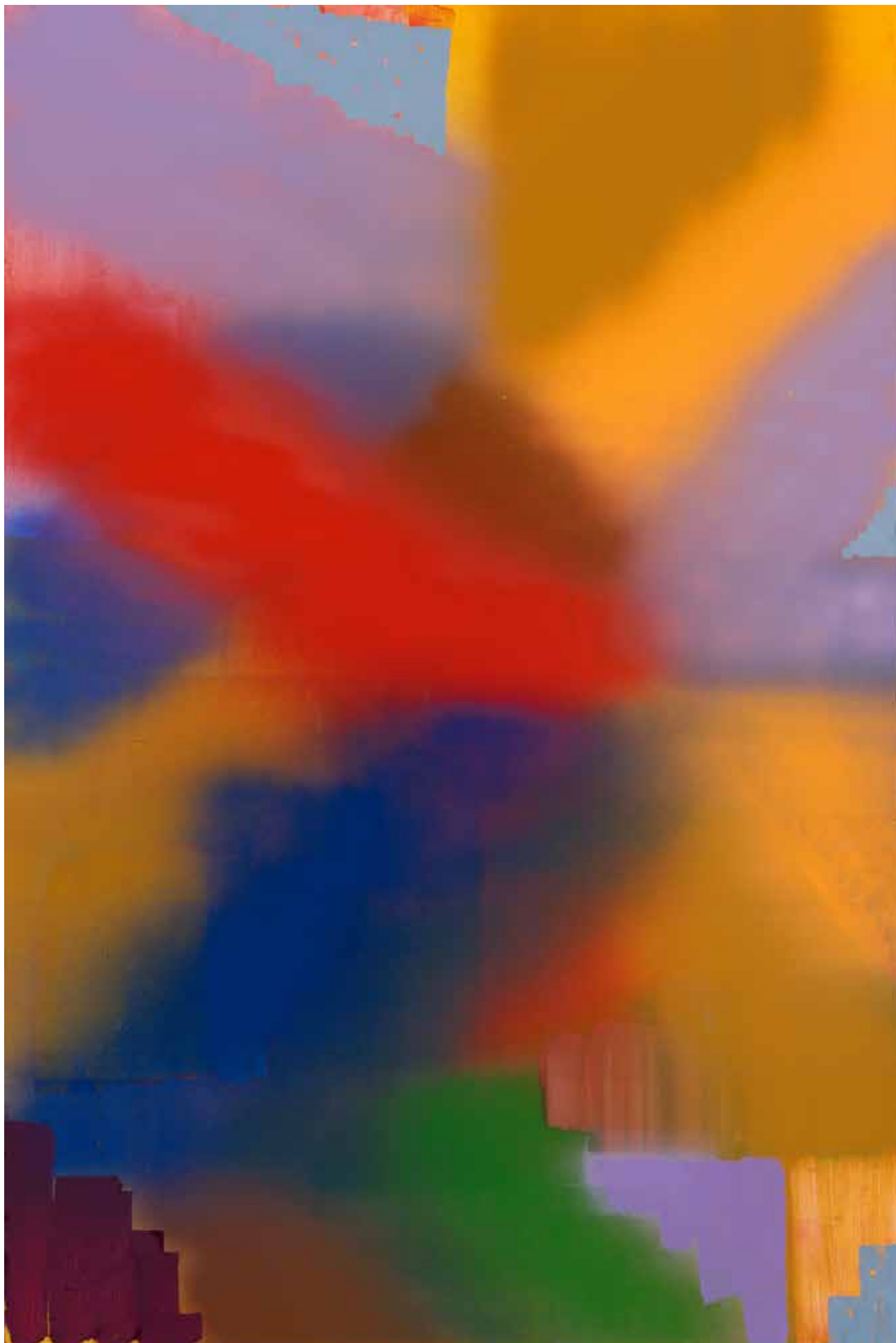

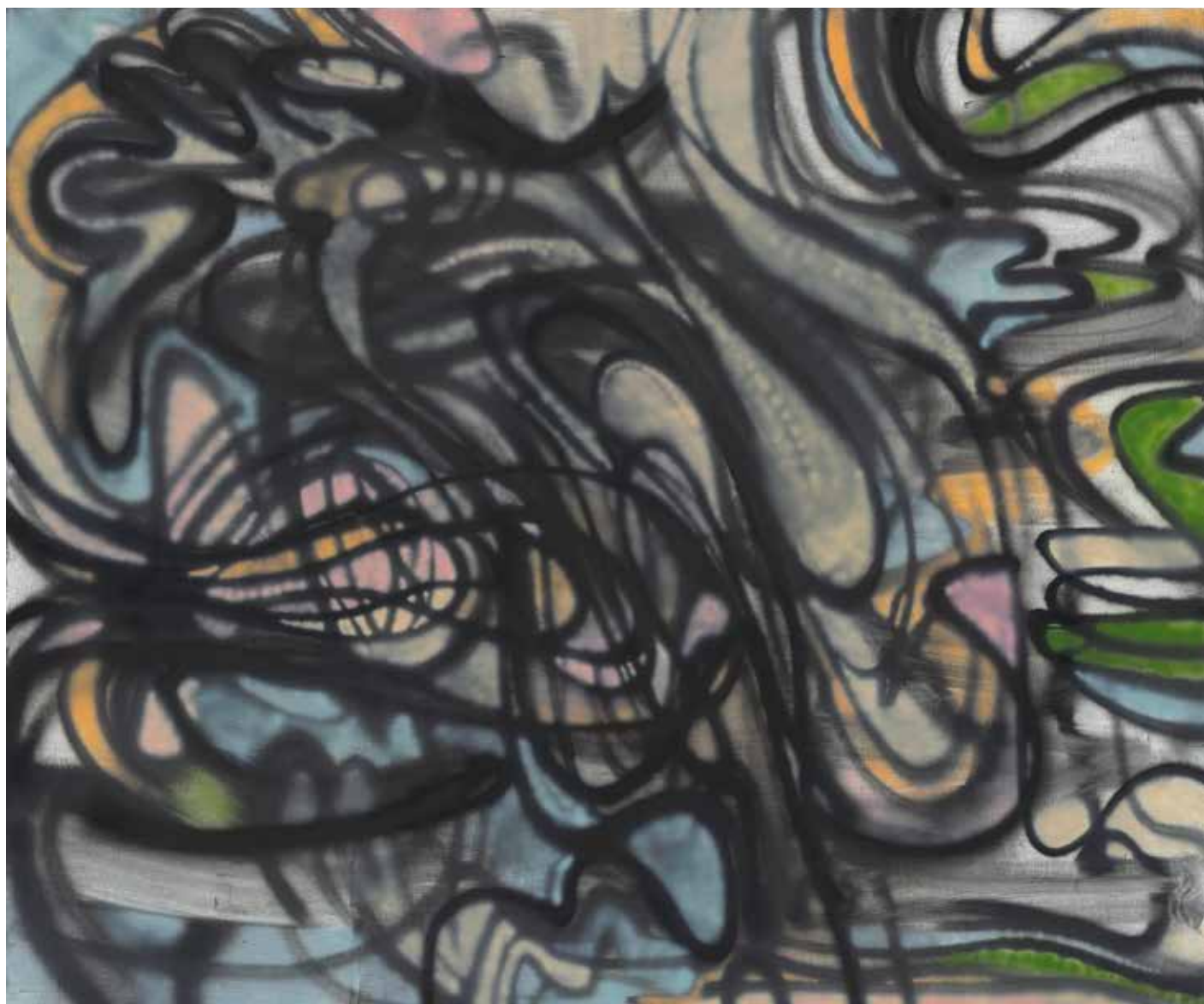




*C*O*N*T*A*C*T*, 2016, oil and acrylic on canvas, 228 x 152,4 cm; 90 x 60"

Robot, 2015, oil and powdered pigment on paper, 101,6 x 66 cm; 40 x 26"





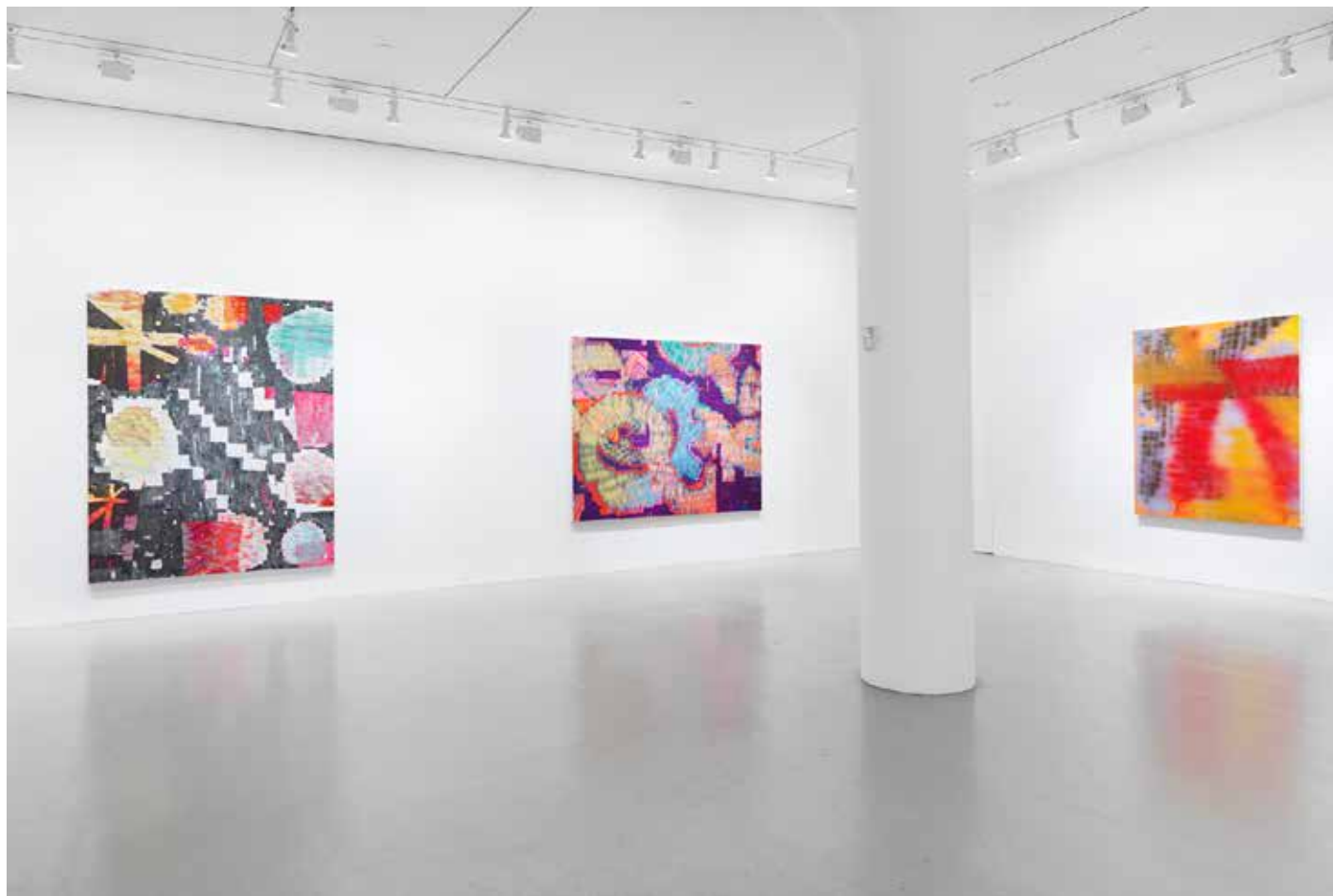
